
## Your Presentation (45 minutes)

We are interested in learning about your scope, process & impact. Your audience will be a larger group of cross-functional partners who you will later meet individually with.

**INTROS (5 MINS):** Start out with a little bit about you, your background, hobbies, passions, interests, or what inspires you.

**CASE STUDIES (30 MINS):** Walk us through two examples of your previous work. Please share one project you have learned from and where you might change approach if able to do it again and one project that you believe is exemplary of your product thinking and user experience design.

**QUESTIONS & ANSWERS (10 MINUTES):** Answer questions from the team.



## 1:1 Interviews (45min)

Your interviewers will be a mix of product managers, designers, researchers, engineers, and your hiring manager. Each interviewer will want to get to know more about you and understand your experience in the following areas:

- Design thinking and problem solving (we will do a collaborative problem solving exercise using Invision Freehand or any prototyping tool of your choice)
- Your perspectives on design
- Communication and collaboration

You'll have scheduled breaks throughout the day. If schedules permit, we also try to book an "Ask Me Anything" 45-minute lunch to ask more questions and get to know the additional members of the team.
